- Check in with older friends and family members to make sure they are staying cool during a heat wave.

Prepare for Extreme Weather

- <u>Download the FEMA app</u> and get weather alerts from the National Weather Service for up to five different locations anywhere in the United States.
- <u>Create an emergency plan</u> so that you and your family know what to do, where to go, and what you will need to protect yourselves during extreme weather.
- Plan ahead if you need to evacuate due to extreme weather. Make sure you and your family know at least two evacuation routes to get to a safe place.
- <u>Build an emergency supply kit</u> for your home if you have to shelter in place, and have one you can take with you if you have to evacuate.
